

WHAT IS NOVICE ALL STARS?

- ★ SoCo's novice all star cheer competitive team performs in a similar fashion to our prep teams, and is the perfect step before being on a prep/elite all stars team. The novice routines are limited to 1.5 minutes long. The routine will include tumbling, jumps, stunt, pyramid, & dance skill sections. The novice team performs for a rating not placement. (Example: instead of 1st/2nd/3rd placement, the judges award novice teams a rating of superior/excellent/outstanding) They will also ONLY compete in the Tulsa area at one day competitions on Saturdays. No out of town travel is required.
- ★ The novice division is a great step to get the real competition cheer vibe and have a little more structured routine/practice regiment that will focus on perfecting the team's routine. Our novice team will practice two times per week for 60 minutes.
- ★ Practices are for perfecting the competition routine and are not tumbling class. The athletes will perform tumbling skills they have already perfected.
- ★ If you are interested in signing up for tumbling class, all star athletes receive a \$20 discount on classes!

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

- ★ The novice team will practice on Tuesdays & Thur. 5:30pm-6:30pm.
- ★ Practices will begin on Tuesday, September 3rd.
- ★ The last practice will be on Thursday, April 3rd.

RENTAL UNIFORM

- ★ SoCo offers rental uniforms that you can borrow for the season.
- ★ Uniform rental cost = \$100
- ★ We have a limited selection of uniforms & rent them out for the season on 1st come 1st serve basis. (*Please note, that if we do not have a rental uniform in your athlete's size, you will have to purchase a new uniform.)
- ★ If you would prefer to purchase a brand new uniform that you can keep, please contact Gabbi at the SoCo office ASAP. It can take 10-12 weeks for a new uniform to arrive after ordering so we will want to get the new uniform ordered ASAP. The cost of a new uniform is approximately \$485.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

All star competitive cheerleading requires a financial commitment, and it is very important you read and understand all obligations. We do our best to be good stewards of your money and strive to make this as affordable as possible. We also have a very active booster club to help you meet the financial demands of the sport.

TUITION + FEE POLICY

- ★ SoCo requires all primary account holders to keep a VALID stored payment method on file, which includes credit or debit card.
- ★ Payments will be automatically processed on the 1st of the month. If credit card is declined you will receive an email notifying you to update CC on file. If payment is not received by the morning of the 5th, a late charge of \$10 will be added to your account.
- ★ All tuition and fees must be current before an athlete may compete, practice, schedule privates, or collect any clothing, uniform or other items.
- ★ No refunds will be given for any reason. Any money you have already paid will remain on your SoCo account.
- ★ If an athlete is injured, quits, or is dismissed from the program:
 - Any past due account charges must be paid in full.
 - SoCo will also charge your account the remaining pro-rated tuition. (*Please keep in mind that the fees are all broken down within the one year All Star commitment as shown below.)
 - If the competition bow/ makeup has been ordered, it will be the property of SoCo and will be used for your replacement.

USASF MEMBERSHIP

- ★ USASF Membership Fee, \$49, must be paid in order to participate. If you have never cheered before as an All Star athlete, at any level, you must register upon accepting a role on a SoCo Intensity team.
- ★ Athletes MUST upload a birth certificate or passport to the USASF website.
- ★ If you are already an All Star athlete, at any level, or from another program, you must renew your USASF membership.
- ★ SoCo will email the link to renew/ create your athlete's USASF membership once team's have formed. There will be a tentative deadline to renew the USASF membership by Thursday, September 12th.

WHAT TEAM IS RIGHT FOR ME?

NOVICE

For individuals who are new to All Star but ready for performance-based teams that are evaluated at events. Novice teams focus on strengthening technique and performance skills that help prepare athletes for competitive All Star teams.

PREP

For individuals with tumbling experience who want to strengthen technique and performance skills in a competitive team atmosphere. Prep teams typically require less time and cost commitments than are required of All Star Elite teams.

ELITE

For individuals with strong cheer training & solid technical ability. Elite teams are comprised of athletes who are ready for highly competitive performance levels. Elite athletes choose competitive all star cheer as their main priority over other extracurricular activity.
